



Outcome of Evaluation for Subsidised Aged Residential Care Beds Numbers– 30 June 2004

Capital and Coast District Health Board approved the following contractual variations after the evaluation round following the receipt of proposals on 30 June 2004.

Kapiti:

Kena Kena Rest Home – five additional Rest Home beds from 23 July 2004.

MetlifeCare Coastal Villas – the transfer of seven Continuing Care to seven Rest Home beds from 9 September 2004.

Porirua:

Kemp Home and Hospital – the transfer of five Continuing Care to five Rest Home level beds from 4 August 2004.

Wellington:

No changes or additions.
