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Summary Highlights for December – January 2019

Notable achievements December - January

- ✓ Confirmed membership of HOP and confirmed Kate Scott and Kirsty Lennon as co-chairs of the group.
- ✓ Health of Older People (HOP) recommendations paper has been written to support the MOC work under the ICCHOP steering group. UK learnings in the frailty recommendations will support the MOC work. The HOP Steering Group has prioritised three recommendations that will support acute flow through the hospital.
- ✓ Acute and Community Care team discussed proposed changes to cellulitis pathway and the likely impacts on POAC.
- ✓ Over 180 people transported by ambulance to their GP in Kapiti. CARS analysis shows evidence on an impact on cumulative incidence in ED presentations from people from Kapiti.
- ✓ Pilot of Shared Care Plan finished, and Evaluation of pilot has been documented. HCH team agreed to support current Indici practices to utilise the tool in a standardised way to capture Year of Care plans within their practice.
- ✓ AWHI (Advancing Wellness at Home Initiative) pilot funding confirmed to June. Initial evidence shows an average of two bed days saved per person. Evaluation underway with options to support roll out to support discharge for people living in Porirua and Kapiti, and from Kenepuru hospital is underway.
- ✓ Head and Neck Oncology Allied Health Project delivering early intervention to prevent admissions and decrease length of stay. 43% decrease in admissions and 47% decrease in bed days from 2018 to 2019.
- ✓ Allied Health telehealth project underway to support implementation of telehealth across Allied Health services.
- ✓ Community Health Networks planning is continuing, with a focus on collaborating across the Localities and Mental Health Wellbeing networks workstreams.
- ✓ Waiver from MOH to enable pilot of paperless prescription software signed off
- √ 43 CCDHB practices are pro-actively falls screening enrolled population; 1428 screen completed.
- √ 824 POAC interventions for the period Feb 19 to Jan 20 in CCDHB and an additional 161 minor gynae
- ✓ All tranche 3 HCH GP practices MDT established and reached maturity
- ✓ Influenza planning for 2020 is underway.

- ✓ ICC Endorsement of the Integrated Primary/Secondary Management of the Diabetic Foot Model of Care
- ✓ Sex and Gender Diverse Working Group is now sub-regional (3DHB)
- ✓ SGDWG has had a successful planning workshop with a five year outlook
- ✓ A planning workshop was held in January to begin development of a pathway for gender affirming mastectomy
