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Summary Highlights for August – September 2020

<p>Notable achievements</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Kapiti workshop held about the Kapiti Community Health Network – over 70 people attended. ✓ 507 HealthPathways and >2.37m page cumulative views since launch. Compared to the same period last year (1 Aug 2019 – 30 Sep 2019) growth in users and page views increased by 24.71% and 29.91% respectively. ✓ SLM partners met to initiate implementation of the 2020/21 SLM plan ✓ CSI MDTs have been successfully handed over to Tū Ora Health Care Home team. This will improve the quality and processes of MDT for practices and CSI teams across the DHB region. ✓ Child Health Network met and firmed up implementation and actions for the 2020/21 SLM plan. ✓ Membership revised for the Health of Older People Steering Group to enhance cross system representation and promote 2DHB collaboration and to enable ELT participation at the right levels within the ICC.
