Who we are

Community Health Services provides health care and home support services to clients living in the community. We have three bases: Wellington, Kenepuru and Kapiti.

How the service is provided:

District nurses provide specialist nursing care. Home visiting is provided to house-bound patients, and we offer nursing clinics at each base for those patients who are not housebound.

Once you have been referred to the Community Nursing Service, a nurse will contact you to assess your nursing care needs, and you will either receive visits at home, or be asked to attend the clinic. The early appointments are popular and we are sorry if we can't give you your choice but will offer you alternatives.

You will be discharged from the District Nursing Service when your plan of care has been achieved, when you no longer require specialist nursing care, or when your needs can be met by your GP, Practice Nurse or other Health Care Provider.
