## General eye care

- Leave your eye patch on until the morning after the operation. Please do not replace it.
- After removing your eye patch, you may need to bathe your eyelids if they are sticky. You are aiming to clean the eye lashes, not the eye itself.
- Do not poke, rub or scratch your eye.


## To bathe the eyelids

1. Boil some water, and then allow it to cool in a clean cup or bowl.
2. Wash your hands.
3. Moisten a clean tissue in the cooled boiled water. Keeping your eye closed, use this tissue to wipe across the eye from your nose to your temple. Throw this tissue away.
4. Repeat step 3 as necessary until the eyelid is clean.

If you have been prescribed eye ointment and eye drops, use the eye drops first and then the eye ointment. If you have more than one eye medication to use, allow 5 minutes between each medication.

## How to use your eye drops

- Wash your hands.
- Remove the lid of the bottle. It is important to keep the bottle tip clean by not letting it touch your hand or the eye.
- Gently pull down the bottom eyelid. Tip your head back and look up.
- Holding the bottle at least 2 cm above your eye, allow one drop to fall into the centre of the lower lid.
- Replace the lid of the bottle.
- If you have more than one eye medication to use, allow 5 minutes between each medication.


## How to use your eye ointment

- Wash your hands.
- Remove the lid of the tube. It is important to keep the tube tip clean by not letting it touch your hand or the eye.
- Gently pull down the bottom eyelid. Tip your head back and look up.
- Holding the tube at least 2 cm above your eye, allow 2 cm of ointment along the lower lid.


## Contact a Doctor for help if you have the following:

- You are taking regular pain relief and are still in pain.
- Loss of vision.
