# **Breast Needle Biopsy**

## **FNA and Core needle biopsy**





Radiology Services – Mammography

Please read this information sheet before your appointment. You will be able to ask questions before your needle biopsy.

### Why am I having a needle biopsy?

A biopsy is done to diagnose (find out) the cause for the breast lump or calcifications the radiologist (Xray doctor) can see on your mammogram or breast ultrasound.

## What happens?

After cleaning the skin with antiseptic, the radiologist will inject the breast skin with local anaesthetic to numb the area.

A needle is then used to take out some breast tissue. There are 2 types of needle biopsy:

#### Fine Needle aspiration (FNA)

This is usually used to 'suck out' cells from a lymph node in your armpit. It can also be used to drain fluid from a breast cyst.

#### Core needle biopsy

This is used to take several pieces of tissue from a solid lump. This requires a little cut in the skin which is too small to need a stitch.

Afterwards we will press the breast to stop the bleeding then put a waterproof dressing on.

The fluid or tissue is sent to the laboratory. The pathologist will study this under a microscope and write a report.

## How long will the needle biopsy take?

Allow an hour for your appointment

#### Can I drive home or back to work?

Yes – but not do heavy lifting or strenuous exercise for 24 hours after your biopsy

## What happens after the biopsy?

After your biopsy you will have a bruise and it may be a little sore. Occasionally it may bleed again and rarely become infected. Serious complications are very rare. You may have a small scar after a core biopsy. See your GP if you have any concerns.

## How will I get my results?

You will get an appointment in the mail or by phone. This appointment is about 2 weeks after your biopsy and is to talk about your results. This will be at the Breast Clinic at Wellington or Kenepuru Hospital outpatient departments.
