

The Children's Community Team is a team of experienced community nurses who work within the Child Health Service from bases at Kenepuru Hospital and Wellington Hospital.

The team is part of the Children's Health Service multidisciplinary team. They provide specialist paediatric nursing care and support to children, young persons and their families from birth to 16 years of age.

The team incorporates general, specialist, discharge planning and liaison nursing support with a focus on promoting self-management. Nurses will assist with care co-ordination and management of essential medical equipment and can provide a link between hospital and home.

Children's nurses will visit children and young people in the community by providing nursing services in the home, outpatient clinics, school, day care or kohanga reo or any area that supports the child's health needs
