Competency 2.7

2.7 Provides health education appropriate to the needs of the client within a nursing framework.

Describe an example of education you gave to a patient or family/whanau or significant other and how you evaluated its appropriateness.

What did you teach them? How did you do this in a way that was appropriate? What did you do to ensure that they understood?

Describe an example of some health education you gave a person – talk about what it was, why they needed it etc

AND

How did you evaluate its appropriateness? How did you know the person understood? How were you satisfied that your education was successful?

PDRP Transfers

Your PDRP needs to reflect your current level of practice in your current area of practice.

The transfer of PDRP is required for:

- Existing employees with a current PDRP when they transfer to a new role within the organisation (internal transfers).
- Nurses who are new to the organisation (external transfers) with a NCNZ approved PDRP within the last three years when they start a new role with the DHB.

The PDRP will be transferred for 12 months from the date of employment.

To remain current on the PDRP, a full new portfolio of evidence at the relevant level and area of practice must be completed and assessed prior to the end date of the transfer.
