People awarded this Certificate would have gained knowledge in Hauora, Advocacy, Supervision, Treaty of Waitangi, and Tikanga Māori.

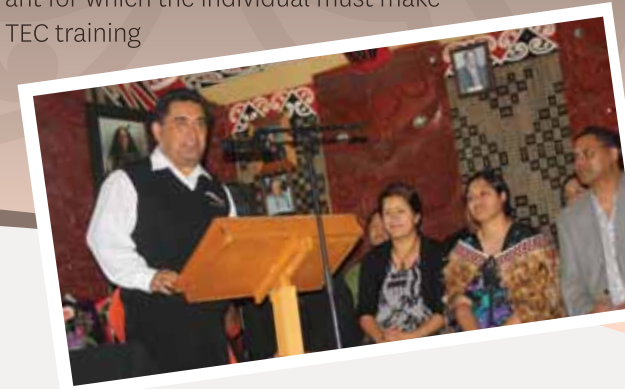
