ATTENTION!!!! Expert & Accomplished Portfolio's

- Portfolios that are sent to the Nursing and Midwifery Office (NAMO) for portfolio assessment at panel, will need to have 1 Portfolio Assessment Tool (PAT) done in the clinical area that needs to be delegated by the endorsing manager. If a PAT has not been completed the portfolio will be sent back to the portfolio owner/clinical area and have this completed, before it can be assessed at panel.
- If there are any portfolio requirements that are missing from the submitted portfolio, this will be sent back before any assessment can be made.
